Dear Customer,

As part of the improvement in the service of the Standards Institution of Israel, we have focused on developing a computerized system (**Meitav/Maslul**) that supports the imported goods certification process, pursuant to the Free Import Order, from the stage of inputting the application through to the receipt of an official standard certificate.

Using an interactive Internet form, it will be possible to send the "application" together with its attachments through the computerized system, quickly, safely and under guidance, with no additional paperwork. Our system will update you, continuously and immediately, on the status of the "application," through the **Maslul** program, by sending personal notices to your email address.

We are presently preparing for the activation of the computerized system, which is scheduled to go on the air on June 15, 2011. In this framework, we will begin the process of inputting powers of attorney and other forms which are necessary for working with the system.

As a threshold condition for working with the Standards Institution through the Internet system, the forms appearing on the SII's website (www.sii.org.il) must be downloaded and forwarded to the SII's finance department, by May 31, 2011 at the latest, bearing the signatures of the persons with authority to sign.

Below is the list of forms which you must complete, sign and forward to the SII's finance department:

1. **Customs broker's authorization (power of attorney)**
2. **Importer's undertaking**
3. **Customs broker's undertaking**
4. **Conditions for ordering a test**

For your information, and to eliminate doubt, without the above forms the SII will not be able to provide you with any service for the receipt of an official standard certificate for imported goods (allowing the marketing or sale thereof).

You are requested not to make any changes in the contents of the documents. Forms in which changes have been made will be disqualified!
